I am a police officer for the City and County of Denver, Colorado, and have knowledge regarding the arrest/incident of the above named party for the below listed offense, which offense occurred on or about the date of 07/27/2020 at 3:13 pm at or near the location of 4020 N CHAMBERS RD in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The probable cause of the arrest of the above-named individual is as follows:

The investigation disclosed that on July 27, 2020, at approximately 1513 Hrs. the victim [REDACTED] (DOB 12 [REDACTED] 1968) went to Wendy's at 4020 N Chambers Rd. He left his vehicle - a white Chevy Malibu bearing Colorado Temp Tag 1940553 unlocked with keys inside the vehicle. While the victim was inside the Wendy's, a suspect (later identified as Allen, Donne 04-10-1999) got into his vehicle and removed it from that parking lot without victim's knowledge or consent.

The victim was able to use GPS technology that was in the vehicle to track it to the parking lot of Macy's at 8298 E Northfield Blvd. Victim's friend was in the location and saw the vehicle parked in the lot. That friend then observed as the suspect approached the vehicle, with an obvious intent to get into it. That friend confronted the suspect, who admitted that keys to the vehicle are in it.

Denver Police Officers responded and arrested the suspect near-by. Upon search incident to arrest of the suspect, a Colorado ID card was located on him in the name of [REDACTED] (DOB 04 [REDACTED] 1998), Colorado PIN [REDACTED]. The photo of the individual on the card strongly resembles the suspect. However, MorphoID device was used to confirm suspect's identity and it was clearly not him.

Northfield security provided CCTV footage to responding officers that showed the suspect driving the stolen vehicle.]
